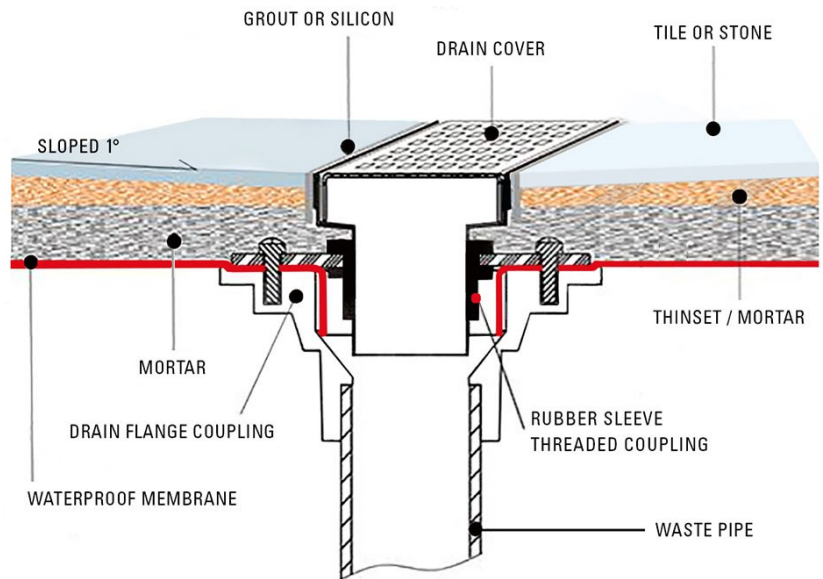


## Installation Instructions

### Linear Drain Contents

1. Drain Cover
2. Drain Base
3. Adjustable Leveling Feet
4. 2" Threaded Coupling Adapter
5. Debris Basket
6. Lifting Key

Note: Please do not remove the Drain Cover from its protective bag until step 8 below has been completed.



1. Remove and discard the traditional strainer barrel from the clamp down drain base.
2. Thread the 2" coupling adapter into clamp down drain base
3. Determine finished height of drain and push drain channel into the 2" threaded coupling adapter.
4. Level linear drain channel by rotating feet by hand, counterclockwise to raise or clockwise to lower drain.
5. Pour concrete/mortar in a sloped direction towards the linear/square drain channel. Maintain slope towards drain 1°. Once concrete/mortar has cured, install thin set and tile per manufacturer's recommendation.
6. The finished tile height should be about 1/16" higher than the linear drain channel edge.
7. Apply a thin bead of silicone around the drain to fill any gaps between the drain channel edge and the tile.
8. Remove grate from protective bag and insert the grate into the drain channel.
9. For tile-in options, install matching tile inside the tile-in grate or flip the tile-in grate for a modern, stainless look.

#### INSTALLATION TIPS

- The manufacturer recommends that linear drains be installed by a professional, experienced installer.

## **Installation Instructions**

### **Care & Cleaning Guidelines**

**MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:** Grates are easy to clean with approved stainless-steel cleaners such as soap and water, Bar Keepers Friend, or Soft Scrub. Use a sponge to clean then rinse and wipe dry.

Do not use tile cleaners, clog remover cleaners, rust cleaners, or chlorine bleach cleaners on your stainless-steel grate.

Do not use steel wool, wire brushes, or other abrasive scrapers to clean the grate.

Grate and debris basket can be removed for cleaning using the lifting key. Insert the lifting key towards the edge of the grate and pull up to expose the debris basket. Empty the contents of the debris basket into the trash and rinse before placing it back into the drain.
